

The Career Services Office would like to share with you the recent developments and events during the past few months, which has been a really busy and fruitful period for the office.

Job postings

In the first quarter of 2006 altogether 62 vacancies were posted to our students in the Career Services shared folders or emailed to a specifically selected group of them. From this number only 24 mentioned the knowledge of Hungarian as a requirement, i.e. 38 postings were available to our non-Hungarian students. 6% of the non-Hungarian positions offered employment in Hungary, 39% in the region and 55% somewhere else in the world (eg. Germany, France, Greece, UK, USA). The vacancies arrived from companies including **General Motors, SAP, IFR Monitoring (UK), P&G, KPMG, Siemens, Amrop Hever, Adecco, FMC Consulting, Moloney Search (Graduate Recruitment, UK), Pravda Capital, Softwin Romania, CVO Group UK, Pedersen & Partners, Apple Search Romania, Euro-Phonenix, ProfiPower and IEurope.**

Networking events / Corporate Showcase

Our students were invited to participate at 29 professional and/or networking events, including CEU Entrepreneurs Forum, February, March and Spring Viking Club, AmCham Seminar & Cocktail - Tax 2006, Interview Skill Seminar held at the main CEU, upcoming Corvinus and BUTE job fairs, Cyprus International Institute of Management and John Church, Principal of Waterstone Capital Advisors' very informative and highly attended Corporate Showcase.

Upcoming events in the next quarter will include CEU Job Fair on 12 June 2006 (organised with the CEU Career Services), an Assessment Center Workshop by **Hudson** and a **General Motors** Corporate Showcase.

Career consultations

About 80 consultations took place in the past few months, most of them as an obligatory part of Business Communications as for the first time attending one Career Consultation Session became a requirement of the course. These in-depth career consultations respond to the ever-changing needs of the students, with topics ranging from practical advice (making the most of our Career Services Resources and corporate/alumni contacts) to more "philosophical" ones (eg. gaining developmental understanding of their strength and weaknesses, exploring their opportunities, discussing various career paths, working out action plans for their job search to make their transition back to career as smooth as possible.)
