### HOUSING POLICY - Academic Year 2008-2009

#### I, the undersigned

- am aware that housing is provided by CEU in Budapest,
- am aware that housing is considered to be an integral part of the program offering.
- am aware that all first-year undergraduate students are required to live in residence. (Students with parents or legal guardians living in Budapest will be exempt from this requirement.) Students are expected to stay in the University housing while in Budapest.
- am aware of the following Housing Policies and to accept the University's rules regarding the rooms allocated to the program,
- am aware that there are additional CEU Housing Policies which will be specified in further detail should I be accepted to and enrol in the undergraduate program.

#### Rules and Regulations:

Violation of one or more of the following rules may become the basis of a disciplinary action made against students:

- a. Students may not sublease the room, or use it in any manner other than as a personal residence.
  - b. Students are aware that they are not permitted to have overnight guests (between 12.00 p.m. - 8.00 a.m.).
  - c. Students or their guests may not organize or hold parties anywhere on the premises of the residence.
    - d. Possession of alcohol is permitted by legally-aged students for personal use only.
1. Students declare to be responsible for the condition of their room and all its furnishings as well as for any damage caused therein by them and/or their guests.
  2. Students recognize that the Dormitory personnel or their designate have the right to enter the room during normal working hours for cleaning and maintenance.
  3. Students will not be allowed to change, modify or alter the room, its fixtures, furnishings and equipment.
  4. Students are expected to leave the room and housing premises in a clean and orderly manner with the same University furnishings which were provided at the check-in. They will be held responsible for any missing or damaged furniture, fixtures or decoration.
  5. Students are aware of the following prohibitions:
    - a. Tampering with fire safety or other safety and security equipment.
    - b. Drying or hanging clothes on the roof or terraces, or outside the windows of the room or building.
    - c. Letting anything whatsoever, including water, fall from the windows or out the doors of the premises.
    - d. Having pets in the room.
    - e. Possession of flammable or hazardous material.
    - f. Possession of illegal substances (drugs or otherwise).
    - g. Possession of fire arms.
    - h. Use of fire/emergency exit doors without proper cause.
  6. Students are expected to make every effort to ensure a pleasant, safe, and secure living experience for everybody living in the Residence.
  7. Students must respect the housing payment deadlines and make their payments in a timely manner. Failure to meet financial obligations may result in suspension of access to dorm facilities or expulsion from the dormitory.

I have read and understood all the rules and regulations specified above. Should I be accepted and enrol in the undergraduate program, I agree to abide by all of the aforementioned regulations and am aware that there may be additional rules and regulations specified in the individual dormitory policies.
